FEATURES:

Provide and Install New 16,224.9 Linear Ft. (5 Km) Anti Force Protection (ATFP) PERIMETER FENCE and Road at NORTHWEST FIELD ANDERSEN AIRFORCE BASE. Provide with new galvanized 8 feet high Gauge 9, 2" square mesh Chain Link complete with Reinforced Concrete post spaced at 10 ft. on center



Provide and Install new additional 1500 LF of 7 feet high perimeter chain link fence. Construct 2 auxiliary vehicle access gate 24 ft in width with permanent ATFP installed equipments at locations indicated on the Plan ,new Vehicular swing gates & access gates complete with welded hinges ,can resist a max wind load of 175 mph and meets AT-FP high security requirements.



Install new ¾ inch ATFP Crash Cable 30 inches from the finish grade secured to buried 3 feet wide x 3 feet length x 4 feet deep concrete deadman anchors.

Install new 3 lines of barbed wire and accessories (high security as per ATFP requirements.

Construct / widen existing 2 sliding ALUMINUM front gate located at Det. 5 to accommodate wider vehicle from existing 14 ft to 20 ft wide.



Relocate 2 EA Motor Gate including Electrical control panel , feeder wires, conduits, sensor , etc. at existing gate located at Det.



Provide thermoplastic reflective paint for steel bollards (traffic safety yellow color) and gate concrete columns for security purposes. Reflective paint stripes for the gate column shall be in 45 degree angle for maximum reflective vision during night time.
